Thank you for your e-mail¹ of 21 May 2020 and sorry for the late reply. You ask about the possibility to include non-organic protein feed (corn gluten) in compound feed for laying hens organically reared.

In principle non-organic protein feed is not authorised in accordance with Article 14(1)(d) of Regulation (EC) No 834/2007² and Article 22 of Regulation (EC) No 889/2008³. However, as mentioned in your letter, it can exceptionally be used in accordance with Article 43 of Regulation (EC) No 889/2008 when the conditions are fulfilled. This is a direct authorisation within the limit of the provisions laid down in this Article.

Regarding Articles 28 and 29 of Commission Regulation (EC) No 889/2008, please note that these Articles refer to non-organic food ingredients and not to feed.

The present opinion is provided on the basis of the facts as set out in your e-mail of 21 May 2020 and expresses the view of the Commission services and does not commit the European Commission. In the event of a dispute involving Union law it is, under the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, ultimately for the European Court of Justice to provide a definitive interpretation of the applicable Union law.
